According to the statistical data submitted by the local authorities on June 1, 1920, there were 2285 people in Maniava: 27 (Roman -Catholics), 2229 Russians and 29 Jews. () CAHJP, Hm2/8888.14

(not including the army register) there were 1896 people in [the census of 1921](#) According to Maniava (921 men, 975 women) : 16 declared Jewish religion while 14 declared Jewish [CAHJP Hm2/9138.6](#) nationality.

Before World War II there were five Jewish families in the village.

Currently, there are 3,400 inhabitants.
