([CAHJP, Hm2/8888.14](#)) people in Maniawa: 27 (Roman -Catholics), 2229 Russians and 29 Jews. (

(not including the army register) there were 1896 people in [the census of 1921](#) According to Maniawa (921 men, 975 women) : 16 declared Jewish religion while 14 declared Jewish [CAHJP Hm2/9138.6](#) nationality.

Before World War II there were five Jewish families in the village.

Currently, there are 3,400 inhabitants.
