Oser Kokesch was a Zionist activist, born in Brody in 1859. After graduating with a law degree from the University of Vienna, Kokesch – together with Smolensky, Birnbaum and Bierer – was one of the founders of "Kadima", a Jewish nationalistic student union. In 1890, "Kadima" published its first ". Kokesch was among Herzl's staunchest followers and *Jeschurun Admath*Zionist compilation, " played an active role in setting up the first World Jewish Congress. He was involved in organizing the following six Congresses as well. Kokesch passed away in Vienna in 1905.
