Israel Igel wrote his memories of Solotvina before and during WWII.

A summary of The document:

In Solotvina they did not celebrate birth days. He studied in a traditional Jewish learning room (Cheder). His father was a merchant and had many brothers and sisters. He remembers that most of the family income was invested in giving the children good education including private tutors. The town houses were made of wood and there was a river that flowed through the town. He mentions there were a lot of gristmills. The town had many youth movements (Betar, Dror, Hashomer Hatzair, Bond) including Gordonia which he was a member in.
