582-588 - 'Chapter 147: The New Hebrew Literature': including references to Shir (582), Joshua (Osias) Heschel Schorr (585) and Karl Emil Franzos (588).

589-591 - 'Chapter 148: Jewish Periodicals': including references to 'Bikkurei Ha-Ittim', 'Kerem Hemed', edited by Samuel Leib Goldberg and 'Ha-Boker Or' (589).
